Pecan trees live for up to 300 years and are native to the United States.



It takes 12 years before a pecan tree reaches maturity to start producing these yummy nuts and then they only produce every 2 years.



In the 1940s, James Young shelled pecans in Florence, SC under the Young Pecan brand and became the world's largest pecan shelling operation. Youngs Pecan transitioned to Young's Premium Foods and their flagship store is still in Florence as a stop on the SC Pecan Trail.



Thomas Jefferson planted a pecan tree in his yard and gifted the other founding fathers pecans he grew.



April 14th is National Pecan Day in the US and July 12th is National Pecan Pie Day.



Pecan wood was used for the handles of the Olympic Torches in the 1996 Olympics. Pecan wood is also used to smoke the savory meats you'll find at Piggyback's BBQ & Catfish on the SC Pecan Trail.

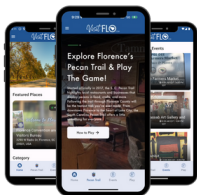

OPTION 2: USE A PECAN TRAIL PASSPORT

Prefer something hands-on? Grab a free passport at any South Carolina Pecan Trail stop or at the Florence Visitors Center located at 3290 W Radio Dr, Florence, SC 29501.

1. Pick Up Your Passport - Available at all participating trail stops.
2. Collect Stamps - Ask for a stamp at each location that you visit.
3. Claim Your Reward - When you're ready to claim your swag, follow the instructions on the inside of the back cover of your SC Pecan Trail passport.
